Part of being in a CSA is the opportunity to know about your food and how it is produced. We want our members to come to our farm and get a feel for what we do. Below is a list of potential events that we would like your input on. We are a small working farm so there might not be space for everyone at some events.

_____ **Pork-apalooza:** (Limited to 20 members)

Thinking about a pork share for this season but wondering how much meat is that really? What kind of cuts, what to do with cuts that aren't familiar? And most importantly how much bacon! Let a professional Chef and Wisconsin Sausage shop owner put your fears to rest as you watch him demonstrate breaking down an half hog into typical cuts while he talks about various ways to prepare them at home. We will then work in small groups for a hands-on sausage making session where you will mix up a recipe and learn to stuff casings using equipment suitable for home use. You will make enough to take some home to your family. We will then settle in for a lunch prepared by the chef featuring pastured pork from Freedom Organix.

_____ **Greenhouse Madness:** (Limited to 2 groups of 3 adults)

Come work with us seeding up trays and general early season greenhouse work. No place is more comfortable and relaxing on a cold sunny day near the end of winter than inside our greenhouse. You can take your coat off, sit in the sun, play in the dirt, and think about all the good things we are growing to eat. When you see the early Bok Choi in your box you'll know that you helped plant it.

_____ **Get Snappy! U-pick Snap Peas** (Limited to 2 groups of 5 families)

Come pick Snap Peas with us before the main season begins. We'll provide picking instructions, containers, recipes and information on how to preserve your peas.

Pre-season (end of May/early June)

_____ **Grow your own Pumpkin** (Limited to 2 groups of 10 families)

Especially for children 7-12. Learn how to grow your own pumpkin.

We provide a chalkboard sign to decorate, selection of seeds (big ones, small ones, white ones, blue ones!), instructions, and your very own 'pumpkin patch' to plant in. Newsletter updates throughout the season. Come back in late September to pick your pumpkin and have lunch with us.

_____ **Cheesemaking** (10 Adults)

We'll make cheese from the milk from cows from a neighboring all natural dairy. We'll start with a tour of the dairy and then return to the farm for instruction on how to make mozzarella and ricotta. You'll have cheese to take home.

_____ **Fall Harvest Party** (Family Event)

Come visit us for an afternoon during Harvest time. We'll have a bonfire, farm tours, good food and you can meet your fellow members.
